DO'S AND DON'T'S FOR AUDITIONS

DO:

- *Become familiar with the music. Callbacks will be singing from the show, and you will have a better chance at a principal role if you know the show.
- *Bring your completed audition form INCLUDING ALL CONFLICTS to your audition.
- *BE HONEST ON YOUR AUDITION FORM!!!!!!!! If you only want to be cast as a specific part or nothing, say so. If you don't want to participate anywhere other than in the cast, say so. I respect your decisions and preferences as long as you are honest with me!
- *Bring sheet music for your audition song. A cappella auditions NEVER go well and are discouraged. You may sing to a karaoke disc but NOT to a CD that already has vocals on it. If you are singing from the show, you don't need to bring sheet music.

DON'T:

- *Tell us you're sick before you sing. If you have complete laryngitis, I'll hear it.
- *Ask to sing with a friend. Even if you don't want a solo in the show, you need to have the confidence to get up and sing something short on your own.
- *Try to figure out who we're going to cast or what we're thinking. You'll drive yourself crazy!
- *Forget to have a good time! The audition process will be as stress-free as possible, so try to have fun with it!
