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COURSE OBJECTIVES FOR EACH CHOIR MEMBER:

The student will:

- 1. PERFORM music in a choral setting, giving attention to expressive quality, artistic creativity and aspects of technical execution.
- 2. IDENTIFY common musical terms, symbols and signs.
- 3. DEVELOP sight-singing and ear-training skills.
- 4. APPLY elements of good vocal production including vowel study and breathing techniques.
- 5. EXPERIENCE music aesthetically, intellectually and emotionally.
- 6. STUDY music from the standard choral repertoire; from different styles and genres.
- 7. DETERMINE the essential sections of musical form in a composition.
- 8. RESPOND to conducting gestures.
- 9. DEMONSTRATE rehearsal decorum and appropriate attitude (attention, cooperation).
- 10. PARTICIPATE in staging and movement activities to enhance musical presentation.
- 11. SING independently with confidence and poise.
- 12. EVALUATE musical performances with critical listening and analysis.

Concert Choir Grading Policy

A student's grade in choir is dependent upon attendance and effort shown in rehearsals and concerts. All students are expected to attend rehearsals and performances in their entirety. If a student needs to leave the concert before its conclusion, permission must be obtained with a note prior to the day of the concert. **Formative Assessments** (Daily Grades, Participation, Performances) are worth 50% of the total grade. Each student will receive a daily grade worth 3 points. Infractions such as tardiness, chewing gum, and disruptive behavior will reduce the daily grade. **Practical Applications** (Written Concert Reviews, Theory assignments, Historical Vocabulary assignments, sight singing and ear training activities) are worth 50% of the overall grade.

Attendance and Participation – Rehearsals

Daily attendance at rehearsals is expected. Students are expected to be punctual and have all necessary materials. A participation checklist is attached. Excused absences from school will not result in a grading penalty.

Any other absences will result in a daily grade of 0. Students are responsible for any work that was missed; practice rehearsal tracks for all pieces are available on the website for home practice. Excessive absences may result in removal from a performance due to lack of preparation. Extenuating circumstances will be dealt with on an individual basis.

Attendance – Performances

Performances are the ultimate form of assessment in music. They are the reason why we do what we do! Attendance is expected at all performances listed on the attached calendar. Excused absences from performances include:

-Illness from school on performance day

-Death or serious illness in the immediate family

Any unexcused absence will result in a grade of 0 for that performance. A checklist for performance grades is attached.

Practical Applications

These include written and oral assignments that demonstrate basic knowledge of music theory, historical periods, and aural skills. Students will work in a theory workbook according to their level of musical knowledge; a pretest at the beginning of the year will determine placement. Other assignments include but are not limited to: historical vocabulary quizzes, readings about historical periods, interval and sight singing activities, and activities to reinforce knowledge of musical terms. Assessment rubrics will be provided for specific assignments in this category.
