



**Who can come?** The camp is open to any student who will enter Grades 4 and up in the fall of 2021. Evergreen Park residency not required.

**What is the schedule?** The camp will meet Monday-Friday from 9 a.m.—3 p.m. from June 15th through July 10th. There will be no camp on July 2nd or 5th for the Independence Day holiday. Performances will take place on July 9th and 10th at 7 p.m. At this time, we intend to present live performances with limited audience attendance and a simultaneous live stream.

**What's the show?** This year's production is "The Lion King, Jr. Experience". Need I say more? Lots of characters to bring to life!

**What will the kids do during camp?** Campers will receive music, dance, and acting instruction as they prepare for their performances. They will also assemble their own props for the show.

**What about COVID?** EP Drama is constantly monitoring the current recommendations put out by the CDC and IDPH. Masks will be required for all campers, and lunch will be eaten outside. Social distancing will be maintaining as much as possible and good hygiene will be emphasized. Enrollment will be limited to assist with social distancing.

**Who will be working with the campers?** Amy Kazin is the director of the camp. She is on the fine arts staff at EPCHS and has been directing shows there since 2000. Students will also interact with other community theater veterans and EPCHS theater alumni and students.

**What is the cost and what does it include?** The cost of the camp is \$225 for Evergreen Park residents and \$250 for non-residents. Tuition includes 3 1/2 weeks of instruction, the student script/workbook for the production, a show t-shirt and an optional post-show picnic on a date to be announced.

**Are there any other hidden costs?** Tickets will need to be purchased for either the in-person performance or the live stream. Prices will not exceed EP Drama's traditional price range of \$5-6. Campers will need basic clothing to serve as a costume for the show, depending upon their character.

**How can I sign up?** Complete the registration form and return with payment to EPCHS to the attention of Amy Kazin. All registration must be accompanied by a deposit that is fully refundable if the camp is unable to run due to renewed COVID restrictions. **Limited space is available**, so sign up now!
