The EPCHS Music Boosters is honored to award several college scholarships for the 2020-2021 school year. A limited number of scholarships will be awarded to students who have participated in the band, choir and/or color guard programs and meet the eligibility requirements outlined below

Applicants, please complete this form and return email it to EPCHSMusicBoosters@gmail.com by midnight on Sunday, April 25, 2021. Once the applications have been received they will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and they will select the winners. Announcement of the awards will be made at the EPCHS Honors Night.

The winners will need to provide to the boosters (1) the name of the school they will be attending and (2) their school (college) identification number (also known as the Title IV Institution code) **by July 9, 2021**, so the payments can be made directly to the school of their choice. *If the student fails to provide their school information by this date, the scholarship will be forfeited.* This identification number is not needed from all applicants, and not necessary to submit your essay.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Graduating Senior
2. Minimum of four (4) semesters of involvement in the EPCHS music program. This may include band, color guard choir or a combination thereof
3. Good academic standing
4. Continue pursuing musical interests in college and beyond
5. Family must be Music Booster Members, membership deadline for scholarship eligibility is February 1, 2021.
6. Must submit scholarship application, including a typed essay (minimum of 300 words) ***by midnight on Sunday, April 25, 2021 to EPCHSMusicBoosters@gmail.com***
