The EPCHS Music Boosters is honored to award several college scholarships for the 2021-2022 school year. A limited number of scholarships will be awarded to students who have participated in the band, choir, and/or color guard programs and meet the eligibility requirements outlined below

Once the applications are received, they will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee, and they will select the winners. Announcement of the awards will be made at the EPCHS Honors Night.

Next, Scholarship winners will need to provide to the boosters:

- 1. The name of the school they will be attending
- 2. Their school (college) identification number (also known as the Title IV Institution Code) by July 1, 2022.

Payments will be made directly to the school of their choice. <u>If the student fails to provide their school information by this date, the scholarship will be forfeited.</u> The identification number is not necessary to submit your essay.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Graduating Senior
- 2. Minimum of four (4) semesters of involvement in the EPCHS music program. This may include band, color guard choir, or a combination thereof
- 3. Good academic standing
- 4. Continue pursuing musical interests in college and beyond
- 5. Family must be Music Booster Members, membership deadline for scholarship eligibility is October 1, 2021.
- 6. Must submit the scholarship application, including a typed essay (minimum of 300 words), by midnight on Wednesday, April 13, 2022 to:
