



Who can come? The camp is open to any student who will enter Grades 4 and up in the fall of 2021. Evergreen Park residency not required.

What is the schedule? June 6-9 from 6-9 p.m. then weekdays from June 13-30 from 9 a.m.—3 p.m. Performances will take place on June 29th at 7 p.m. and June 30th at 10 a.m.

What's the show? This year's production is "Willy Wonka, Jr."Lots of characters to bring to life in this classic take of the search for the Golden Ticket.

What will the kids do during camp? Campers will receive music, dance, and acting instruction as they prepare for their performances. They will also assemble their own props for the show.

What about COVID? EP Drama is constantly monitoring the current recommendations put out by the CDC and IDPH. More specific information regarding any necessary mitigations will be released prior to the start of camp.

Who will be working with the campers? Amy Kazin is the director of the camp. She is on the fine arts staff at EPCHS and has been directing shows there since 2000. Students will also interact with other community theater veterans and EPCHS theater alumni and students.

What is the cost and what does it include? The cost of the camp is \$225 for Evergreen Park residents and \$250 for non-residents. Tuition includes 3 1/2 weeks of instruction, the student script/workbook for the production, a show t-shirt and post-show cast party.

Are there any other hidden costs? Spectators will need to purchase tickets for the performances. Ticket prices are \$5 for adults and \$4 for students/seniors. Campers will need basic clothing to serve as a costume for the show, depending upon their character.

How can I sign up? Complete the registration form and return with payment to EPCHS to the attention of Amy Kazin. All registration must be accompanied by a deposit that is fully refundable if the camp is unable to run due to renewed COVID restrictions. <u>Limited space is available</u>, so sign up now!
