Application submissions for College Scholarships begins: Friday, March 6, 2026

The EPCHS Music Boosters is honored to award college scholarships for the 2025-2026 school year. A limited number of scholarships will be awarded to students who have participated in the band, drama, choir, and/or guard programs and meet the eligibility requirements outlined below.

Applicants, once this form and your essay is complete, send them via email to mzofkie@d124.org. If you choose to share your essay via a google doc, PLEASE ensure that mzofkie@d124.org is given access to your file.

Applications are DUE by 11:59 pm Friday, April 3, 2026

Once the applications are received, the Scholarship Committee will review and select the winners. Announcement of the winners will be made at EPCHS Honors Night followed by an email notification.

Upon receipt of winning notification, scholarship recipients will need to provide the following information to the Music Boosters at epchsmuscboosters@gmail.com:

1. Name of college/university they will be attending
2. College/University address where scholarship check should be mailed to
3. Their school (college/university) identification number (also known as the Title IV Institution Code) **by June 15, 2026.**

Payments will be made directly to the school of their choice. *If the student fails to provide their school information by this date, the scholarship will be forfeited.* The identification number is not necessary to submit your application/essay.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Graduating Senior
2. Minimum of four (4) semesters of involvement in the EPCHS music program. This may include band, guard, drama, choir, or a combination thereof
3. Good academic standing
4. **Family must be Music Booster Members. Membership deadline for scholarship eligibility is October 1, 2025.**
5. Must submit the scholarship application, including a typed essay (minimum of 300 words) by 11:59p on Friday, April 3, 2026 to mzofkie@d124.org.
