



## SUMMER CAMP 2026 INFORMATION

**Who can come?** The camp is open to any student who will enter Grades 4 and up in the fall of 2026. Evergreen Park residency not required.

**What is the schedule?** The camp schedule is as follows:

June 1-4- 6-8 p.m.

June 8-12, June 15-18, June 22-25 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Performances: Dare to Dream, Jr. - Thursday, 6/25 at 7 p.m. and Friday, 6/26 at 10 a.m.

Fame, Jr. - Saturday, 6/27 at 7 p.m., Sunday 6/28 at 2 p.m.

**What's the show?** This year, we'll prepare two shows simultaneously to maximize the feature opportunities for all ages!

Campers entering 4th through 8th grade will perform Disney's "Dare to Dream, Jr.", a story about the imagineers which features all of your Disney favorites! There are lots of opportunities to feature our younger campers in this energetic review.

Campers entering 9th through 13th grade will travel back to the 80's to tell the iconic story of the New York performing arts high school in "Fame, Jr. " There are parts for all, whether singing, acting or dancing is your "thing".

**What will the kids do during camp?** Campers will receive music, dance, and acting instruction as they prepare for their performances. They will also assemble their own props for the show.

**Who will be working with the campers?** Amy Kazin is the director of the camp. She is on the fine arts staff at EPCHS and has been directing shows there since 2000. Students will also interact with other community theater veterans and EPCHS theater alumni and students.

**What is the cost and what does it include?** The cost of the camp is \$225 for Evergreen Park residents and \$250 for non-residents. Tuition includes 3 weeks of instruction, the student script/workbook for the production, a show t-shirt and a post-show cast party on June 28th.

**Are there any other hidden costs?** Tickets for the production itself will be \$5. Campers will need basic clothing to serve as a costume for the show, depending upon their character.

**How can I sign up?** Complete the registration form and return with payment to EPCHS to the attention of Amy Kazin. All registration must be prepaid. **Limited space is available**, so sign up now!
