Week 2

- Monday, August 3 – Friday, August 7
- **1:00 PM – 9:00 PM**

Dinner Break: **5:00–6:00 PM** each day. **BRING A PACKED DINNER.**

Students **must remain on campus** during dinner.

Attendance Policy → TEST GRADE IN GRADEBOOK

- Attendance is **required** for all marching band and color guard members.
 - Marching band is a required extension of the Band and Color Guard curriculum in accordance with district policy and the course syllabus.
 - Students may earn **10 points for each day of perfect attendance**, for a total of **100 points** during Band Camp.
 - **This will be the first summative assessment (100 points) entered on the first day of school.**
 - If a student must miss part or all of a camp day, the conflict **must be communicated in advance by BOTH the student and a parent/guardian.**
 - Communication from a student **without parent/guardian communication** does not constitute an excused absence and may impact the student's grade.
 - Students whose conflicts have been communicated by a parent/guardian will have attendance points **waived** for the affected day(s).
 - Students absent without a valid excuse may not receive full credit for that day's attendance.
 - Students with conflicting school activities must communicate with coaches and club sponsors ahead of time so that proper communication with Mr. Curatolo can be made. **Part-time jobs are not a valid excuse for absences, as this is a class requirement.**
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What to Bring / What to Wear

Students must bring:

- **Instrument or flag bag** with all required equipment
- **Fully charged iPad** (Band only)
- **Charged cell phone** (emergency communication)
- **Packed dinner**
- **64 oz. (or larger) refillable water bottle** (disposable plastic water bottles are not sufficient)

Students must wear:

- Hat and sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Light, athletic clothing
- Socks
- Running or training shoes with proper support

Do NOT wear:

- Vans
 - Converse
 - Crocs
 - Slippers
 - Sandals
 - Flip-flops
 - Any footwear without proper athletic support
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Weather Information

- Band Camp includes both **indoor and outdoor rehearsals**.
 - Most outdoor rehearsal time will take place during the evening as temperatures begin to cool.
 - Staff will continuously monitor heat, weather conditions, and air quality to ensure student safety.
